From Our Pastor...

God's Voice Speaks

As I write my sermons each week I often remember the conversation one of my seminary professors had with me when I was sitting in his office close to graduation and seeking my first "call" as a pastor. With trepidation, anxiety, curiosity, and some fear, I wondered how I would be able to write a different sermon each week. When it was me who was to come up with a fresh outlook, to ancient scriptures, and speak as a "mouth piece" for God to such a variety of listening ears, I just knew it was going to be an impossibility!! Then the profound words came from my seminary professor, "You always preach to yourself first, then God can do the rest." It seems that some weeks more than others, I find myself longing to hear the message I feel called to preach. I know I am a traveler on this journey with each of you, and I find comfort from the prayers we share, and the reflections we have to a text. I am prodded to act and do and become as God's Holy Spirit calls us through our Holy words of Scripture.

This past Sunday, the day after our Apple Butter day, the lectionary scripture was from the book of Esther. It told the story of the young, beautiful Jewish girl, who became the queen of Persia without anyone in the castle knowing of her heritage, not even her husband - the king. A time came when the Jews, who were deeply hated, were to be annihilated. Queen Esther had the opportunity to be silent and keep herself safe, or be courageous and speak for all the Jews who had no voice and ask for justice, and compassion, and their lives to be spared. She had to risk her own safety for others, Because of her courage in speaking up for her people, they were not killed and the whole race was saved.

The words from the scripture which rang in my head were spoken to Queen Esther, by her cousin Mordecai. He persuaded Esther to speak to the king on behalf of the Jewish people He reminded her of her unique place in history and that silence is not an option

Mordecai speaks of God's purposeful timing: "Who knows but that you have come to a royal position for such a time as this?" (Esther 4:14 NIV). In other words, as an article I read suggested, "Mordecai lets Esther know that even her outer beauty was for a reason and would not go to waste!"

For such a time is this..... During my pastorate here at UCC East Goshen, often I have wondered about our congregation, what we are being called to at particular times in the history of our community and our church. But when I heard those words I took them personally. What am I being called to at this time in the history of my life and the needs of the world where I am living? What is the voice of God speaking and nudging me to do? As I mentioned on Sunday, we all have more strength than we can imagine inside. We can do great and wonderful things for God and God's people. Where should my feet, hands and heart be moving?

May this season of harvest and thanks, fill us with a renewal of courage to ask and respond to Mortdecai's question: "Who knows but that you have come to a royal position for such a time as this?"

God be with you as you listen to the sermon you have inside.


"Café Script," the Pastor's discussion group


Indeed, 580 golf balls were dropped from atop East
